

SUNBEAM SHAFT SITE

The Sunbeam Shaft site is located within the **Whiteshell Provincial Park** near Provincial Road 301. The site contains two capped mine shafts, abandoned mine infrastructure, mine waste rock, and deleterious debris.

Timeline and Scope of work:

The expected project duration is four (4) months after completing equipment mobilization. The following construction activities for the mine closure are planned to commence in the summer of 2023:

- Site mobilization. A construction camp is not expected.
- Collection and consolidation of waste rock and metal debris located in the site and disposal into the existing mine shaft.
- Replace the existing concrete caps with a new reinforced concrete cap complete with public safety warning signage and ventilation pipe.
- Installation of chain-link safety fencing around the shaft.
- Buck up larger trees and leave them on-site. Crush and spread smaller trees over the disturbed areas to facilitate re-vegetation.
- Site restoration including erosion control protection /re-vegetation of disturbed areas and equipment demobilization.
