It is the season of Breeding Bird Surveys, and we are looking for volunteers to assist us with one just southwest of Riding Mountain National Park near the town of Rossburn.

**Saturday, June 12th
8:00am to 3:00pm**

The Nature Conservancy of Canada (NCC) in cooperation with Parks Canada and the Manitoba Breeding Bird Atlas Project are holding a one-day Bird-a-thon to record all species of birds found on NCC's 322 hectare (800 acre) Elk Glen protected site.

Camping facilities are available in and around Riding Mountain National Park located near Rossburn, Manitoba and at Deep Lake.

A light lunch and supper will be provided on Saturday. An optional early morning birding opportunity will be arranged on Sunday with departure by 12:00pm.

Breeding Bird Survey Location Map – Riding Mountain Aspen Parkland

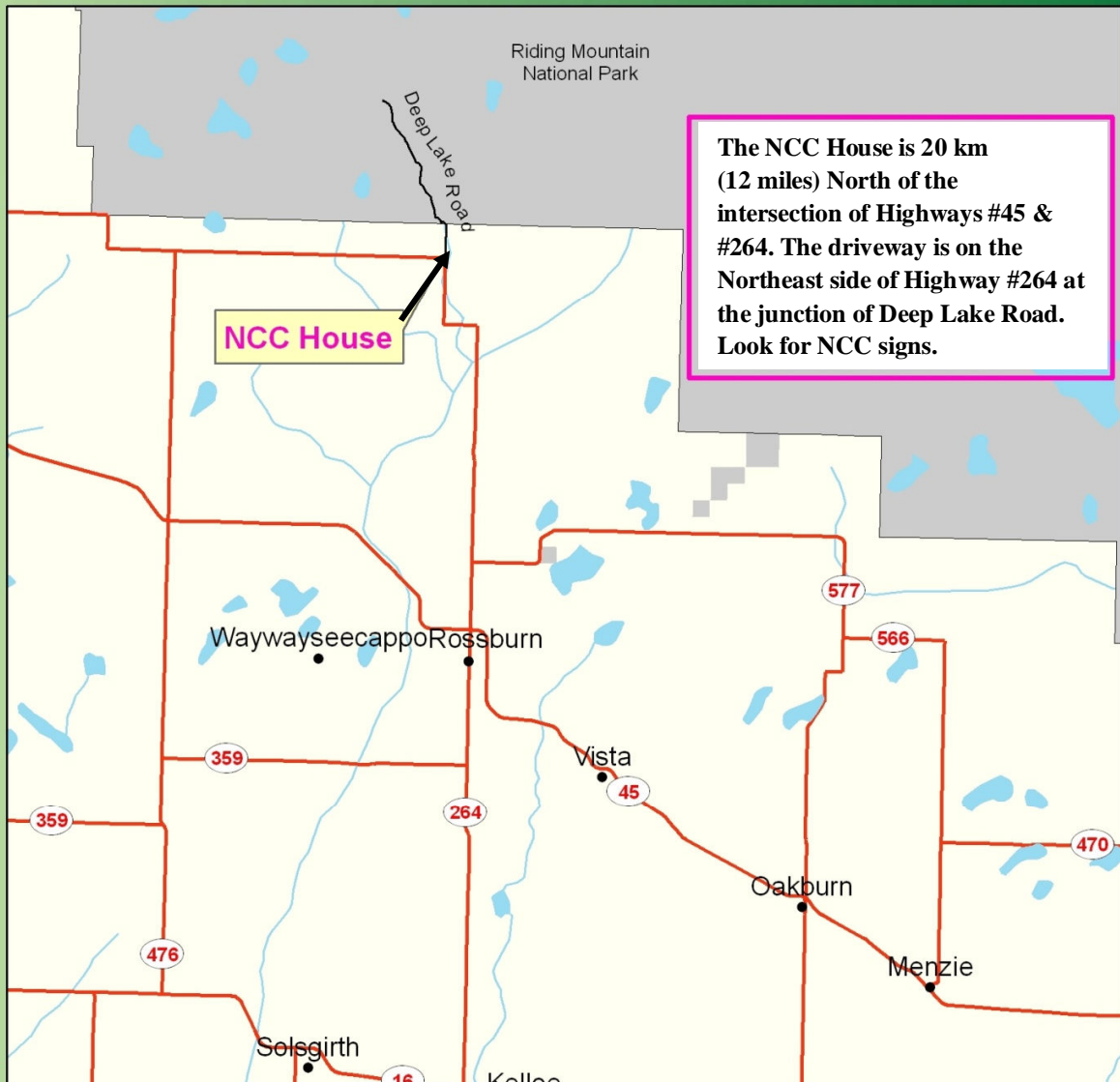
